METAD's modern and controlled wet and dry processing systems keep the focus on quality. In addition to raised drying beds, we have a warehouse and hulling machines on location at our farm sites in Hambela and Gedeb (Gedio Zone). An ecofriendly wet processing (Penagos) infrastructure will be ready for use in the 2014/2015 season.
